Dear Storage Participant: **FACE MASKS MUST BE WORN WHEN YOU BRING IN YOUR VEHICLE FOR STORAGE AND SOCIAL DISTANCING MUST BE OBSERVED.** Please note the following dates have been designated for the 2020/2021 vehicle storage season: **Saturday, October 24, 7:30 a.m. til Noon and Saturday, November 7, 7:30 a.m. til Noon.**

The entrance to the grounds will be, as in the past, from the Ironwood Road Gate #1. **YOU WILL NEED TO REPORT TO THE FAIR OPERATIONS OFFICE BEFORE PARKING YOUR VEHICLE.** The storage program is on a first come basis. Buildings are equipped with fire and theft protection, but are not heated. **NOTE: YOU MUST BRING YOUR OWN TOOLS AND COME PREPARED TO DISCONNECT AND/OR REMOVE YOUR BATTERY/BATTERIES.**

There will be one Saturday for removal, which will be Saturday, March 27, 2021, between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and Noon. In the case of cars and motorhomes, if you were one of the last vehicles parked in a particular building, you must be here promptly on March 27 because until you remove your vehicle, no other vehicles will be able to move out. Please know that there will be an additional outside storage fee of \$10.00 per day, per vehicle, for any vehicle(s) not removed by March 27, 2020.

Our Fairgrounds are COVID-19 Safety Compliant. When you bring your vehicle for storage this year, in an attempt to enforce all appropriate health safety standards and procedures specific to the COVID-19 pandemic, pens and/or pencils and blank Storage Agreement forms will no longer be available. You must have your paperwork fully completed, including license plate number, for the vehicle you are leaving for storage. A hand sanitizing station will be available and everyone must sanitize their hands prior to entering our Operations Office. For your convenience, we have enclosed a copy of the Agreement form you must complete prior to your arrival. Having your paperwork completed when you arrive will help with social distancing as well as helping alleviate waiting in a lengthy line. Additional forms can also be found on our web site at www.4hfair.com.

For the 2020/2021 new rates and early storage rates and procedures will be in effect. These rates are determined by the TOTAL LENGTH, including tongue or other projections. All units will be measured by on-site board and/or staff members. In the case of pontoon boats, rates will include an additional fee to cover width. As in the past, we will again offer an early storage program. Regardless of the type of vehicle and/or unit, early storage will eliminate having to wait in line on either Saturday. The procedure and appointment times for the 2020/2021 season are as follows:


With an appointment beginning October 5, for an additional \$25.00 per vehicle fee over and above the storage rate, along with the Early Rate Per Day Fee, you can drop off your unit/vehicle October 19 to 23, between 8:30 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. The Early Rate Per Day Fee is determined by how many days prior to October 24 you wish to drop off your unit. The Early Rate Per Fee Schedule is attached.

Also new this year, if either the storage Saturday, or the October 19 to 23 early storage dates, are inconvenient to you, using the attached Early Rate Per Day schedule, along with the \$25 early fee, you can schedule to bring in your vehicle/unit beginning September 25.

Note: During early storage, unless your vehicle is a motorhome or car, you will be dropping your vehicles outside the buildings where they will be stored and they will be put inside later that day.
